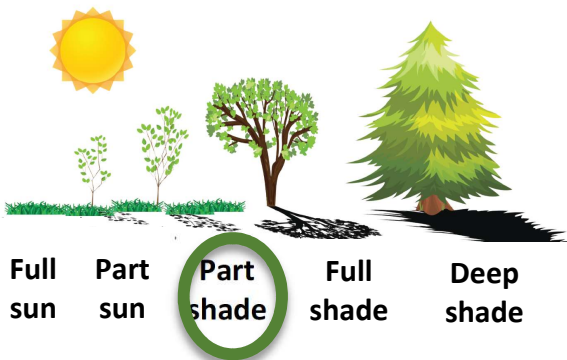

General Comments: Good state park experience overall. Big Rigs BEWARE – There is a seriously tight hair pin curve on the approach road, and getting around the campground to your site may be very difficult. The campground gets very busy with families on weekends.
