NOTES: Facilities are in generally good condition. Main park roads are paved; loop roads are gravel. Some decorative landscaping throughout. Some signs of wear in the common areas but no problem with use of facilities.

General Comments: Very large park with several loops on both sides of the fishing pond. There are cabins for rent and numerous sites are occupied by long term campers. The park has a mix of dense shade to full sun exposure with most sites having at least partial sun. We had a quiet location but sites in Groups E and F are closer to the road and get more road noise.
